

TOWN OF NEWINGTON
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
BARKING DOGS

In order to protect the health, welfare, environment and well being of the people of the Town of Newington, the following regulation shall apply:

It shall be unlawful to keep within the Town of Newington, dogs which bark continuously or with such regularity so as to disturb the peace and tranquility of the people of the Town of Newington.

Any person who violates this ordinance shall be punished in the Municipal Court of the Town of Newington as for violating a Town ordinance. Upon conviction, said person will be charged with a misdemeanor with a maximum fine of \$1000.00.

This ordinance is effective upon adoption.

Adopted by Mayor and Council of the Town of Newington at a regular meeting on the 4th day of March 2004.
