

TOWN OF NEWINGTON
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
THE FLOW OF TRUCK TRAFFIC

#01-98

The existing ordinances of the Town of Newington as to the Flow of Traffic Within the Town of Newington are hereby added to as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any tractor-trailer or loaded trucks in excess of six thousand (6,000) pounds to use the town streets except for the delivery or receiving of goods or on designated truck routes.

2. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be punished in the police court of the town as for violation of a town ordinance.

This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
