

TOWN OF NEWINGTON  
AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL PUBLIC DRUNKENNESS  
IN THE TOWN OF NEWINGTON

At the May, 1991 meeting of the Town of Newington, the following Ordinance was duly read, discussed and passed unanimously, to wit: A person who shall be and appear in an intoxicated condition in any public place or within the curtilage of any private residence not his own other than by invitation of the owner or lawful occupant, which condition is made manifest by boisterousness, by indecent condition or act, or by vulgar, profane, loud, or unbecoming language, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
