ORDINANCE REGULATING SALVAGE YARDS

#01-99

RESPONSIBILITY FOR ADMINISTRATION. This section shall be administered by the Chief of Police

PROHIBITION. No person shall place, abandon, leave, keep or store, or suffer or permit the placement, abandonment, leaving, keeping or storage of nonfunctioning motor vehicles, appliances, machinery, equipment or parts thereof, out-of-doors upon any public or private land within the town.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION. Whenever it shall appear to the Chief of Police that this section is being violated he shall, in writing, notify the owner or tenant in possession of the land on which the violation exists to abate this violation by removing the material or materials to a conforming location, or into an enclosed garage, barn or other building within ten days of the notice.

APPEAL. A person receiving notice of violation of this ordinance may within 30 days appeal the decision to the Mayor and Council stating such reasons as to his lack of compliance with the ordinance and its administration.

PENALTIES. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished in the Municipal Court of the Town as for violating a Town ordinance. Upon conviction, said person will be charged with a misdemeanor with a minimum fine of \$25.00. Each day this violations exists within 14 days after receipt of notice of violation shall be considered a separate offense of violation of this ordinance.
